For its summer 2017 issue, *Family and Community Health* will publish a special issue with focused on “*Community-based Approaches to Cardiovascular Health*”. This issue will be published in the July/September 2017 issue. All *Family and Community Health* articles are peer-reviewed, are indexed through PubMed.

Themes of special interest for the supplement include but are not limited to the following:

- 1) Community-based Approaches on the prevention, detection, evaluation, treatment and control of hypertension and cardiovascular diseases.
- 2) Conceptual and theoretical frameworks with related methods, metrics, and strategies for identifying and disseminating *Community-based* interventions to improve *Cardiovascular Health*.
- 3) Clinical and public health insights gained from hypertension and cardiovascular research studies conducted in non-traditional community settings.
- 4) Strategies for research training and career development that integrates community and the social determinants of health to advance prevention and outcomes of cardiovascular and related disease.
