Special Issue: Trauma Informed Care in Forensic Nursing

The *Journal of Forensic Nursing* is currently seeking original articles, review papers, and case reports for a special issue to be published in 2019 highlighting research and scholarship related to trauma-informed care relevant to forensic nursing. Researchers, clinicians, educators, and others whose work interfaces social justice, violence, issues in criminal justice, health care systems and forensic nursing, are invited to submit articles. All submissions must explicitly address trauma-informed policies and/or practices.

All submissions should explicitly connect to forensic nurses and forensic nursing practice.
