

CALL FOR PAPERS

Journal of Addiction Medicine seeks submissions of papers related to the effects of COVID-19 (SARS-CoV-2) on people with substance use and/or addiction in the categories of Original Research, Brief Reports, (research) Letters to the Editor, Commentaries, and Case Reports (see instructions for authors). All papers will be reviewed quickly and accepted manuscripts will be published soon after acceptance online only and in a rolling fashion, in a collection of papers titled “COVID-19 (SARS-CoV-2) and Addiction”. Please submit them at the Journal via the online manuscript submission system <https://www.editorialmanager.com/jam/default.aspx> and be sure to note in the cover letter that the paper is to be considered for the COVID-19 (SARS-CoV-2) and Addiction collection.

We welcome papers such as, but not limited to, the following: risk for COVID-19, severity of COVID-19, COVID-19 outcomes, addiction prevention and treatment during the pandemic, comorbidities common in people with addiction during the pandemic, and the effects of the pandemic, effects of measures to address it and societal and sociological responses to it (e.g. physical distancing) on people with addiction, effects on social networks, 12-step and other groups, HIV prevention, treatment with medications, psychosocial treatments and technologies, and new policies and their impact.

Published six times per year, and with an Impact Factor of 2.699, the Journal is the official journal of the American Society of Addiction Medicine and goes out to over 5,400 members. The Journal is viewed online almost 300,000 times per year, and papers published in the journal were downloaded over 33,000 times in 2019. The Journal is designed for all health professionals who need to keep up to date with addiction.
