Understanding Injury Prevention Overcoming Adversity Through Personal Tragedy

Dale Spencer was injured due to a fall at NIU on December 2nd, 1988.

Since 1994, Dale volunteers his time for the Illinois State Chapter and the National Office of Think First Injury Prevention Foundation (Sits on the National Board of Directors). He feels that in showing his special story, it will give many teens important things to think about when it comes to safety. Dale made a wrong decision and now he is coping with the consequences. He is happy with his life and cherishes his relationships. This helps with sending his vital message that the majority, if not most, of these spinal cord injuries can be prevented. He advocates "Use your mind to protect your body."

How Healthcare Providers Can Play a Role in Treating or Preventing Intimate Partner Violence

This interactive session will engage participants in a dialogue about the importance of conducting routine screenings for IPV (Intimate Partner Violence).
