MCN The American Journal of Maternal Child Nursing Editorial Fellowship for 2023

We're offering our fourth 12-month editorial fellowship to learn about the journal publishing process that includes the online manuscript submission system, peer review, revisions, editing, writing tips, publication decisions, preparing an issue, ethical issues in authorship, scholarly language, and inclusion of various groups in the research reporting process. MCN fellows work with the Editor-in-Chief and Associate Editor to get exposure to the behind-the-scenes workings of a nursing journal. This opportunity is ideal for early-career nursing scholars who want to learn about what goes on in the background of a nursing journal, enhance their chances of success for journal article publication, and consider the editor or associate editor role for their future.

Requirements:

- Registered nurse
- Maternal or pediatric nursing experience
- Master's degree in nursing or related field or higher
- Want to learn about publishing in a nursing journal

Expectations

Monthly 90-minute virtual sessions with the Editor-in-Chief and Associate Editor on a selected topic of journal operations, scholarly writing, ethics, inclusive language, citations, peer review, authorship, working with authors, artwork, proofs, making decisions about publication, editorial boards, role of editor and associate editor.

Complete at least 6 mentored peer reviews during the 12 months

Contribute to the Toward Evidence-Based Practice column and participate in preparing the column with the Associate Editor

Prepare at least 1 mentored feature article submitted by the end of the fellowship
