### Qualifications

- Assistant Professor or equivalent
- Research record in biobehavioral medicine, health psychology, or a related discipline
- Fluency in English

### Specific Responsibilities

- Conduct up to 3 reviews annually of manuscripts submitted to the journal
- Attend editorial board meetings and participate in activities organized by the journal
- Additional editorial tasks or special projects as requested by the editors
- Serve as an ambassador to promote the journal via academic network, social media, conferences and other channels

### Term

ECEB members will serve a 2-year term with the possibility of renewal for a second term. There is the possibility for ECEB members to be promoted to the Editorial Board.

Interested candidates should submit a CV that includes name, affiliation, degrees and/or qualifications, publications and research projects, and any reviewing or editorial experiences to [editorialoffice@psychosomaticmedicine.org](mailto:editorialoffice@psychosomaticmedicine.org). Applications will be reviewed with an eye toward identifying “rising stars” in the areas of research published in *Psychosomatic Medicine*. Applicants who would contribute to diversity on the ECEB are encouraged to include information to that effect in their email.
