Title: Exercise Training: A Key Strategy in Oncology Rehabilitation

Rehabilitation Oncology seeks high quality papers related to the use of exercise in oncology rehabilitation for the 2024 special issue of the journal. In continuing to serve our mission to further the science and practice of cancer rehabilitation, we are seeking manuscripts that report on the use of prescribed exercise to minimize impairments and improve functional outcomes for individuals with cancer across the survivorship continuum. Specifically, we invite various categories of original research-submissions including systematic reviews, clinical trials, and secondary analyses from clinicians, researchers, educators and survivors that address the therapeutic use of exercise at any point along the entire cancer continuum, with a focus ranging from bench science to innovative clinical applications.
